# **Girls**

Jade Sweatshirt with logo, Jade Cardigan with logo, White Polo Shirt, Navy Shorts Jade Gingham Dress, White Socks, White or Black trainers

#### Boys

Jade Sweatshirt with logo, White Polo Shirt, Navy Shorts, White or Black trainers

Shoes should be sensible and suitable for outdoor wear. We ask that girls' shoes do not have a high heel.

Hair accessories such as slides, ribbons, bobbles etc. should be kept fairly simple.



Pupils can wear school fleeces or waterproof coats or any dark coloured coat.

## **Jewellery**

In the interest of pupil safety it is advisable that jewellery should not be worn to school. However, we appreciate that watches are important and are therefore acceptable. The only permissible exception is the wearing of small stud backed earrings. (Hoop earrings are not to be worn by pupils). However, these must be removed during P. E. lessons by the pupils and are the responsibility of the owner and not the staff in school.

## **The Role of Parents**

We ask all parents who send their children to our school to support the School Uniform policy.

We believe that most parents want to send their children to school correctly dressed and ready for their daily schoolwork. One of the tasks we ask parents to undertake is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform, and that it is clean and in good repair.

If any parent would like the school to modify or deviate from this School Uniform Policy, they should make representation, *in the first instance*, to: the Head teacher.

The school welcomes children from all backgrounds and faith communities. If there are serious reasons, for example on religious grounds, why parents want their child to wear clothes that differ from the School Uniform, the school will look *sympathetically* at such requests.
